FSYO is a charitable organisation whose aim is to support the ensembles that are part of the Southampton Youth Orchestras pyramid (Acorn, Elgar, SYS, SYCS and SYO). The FSYO committee members are parents of current players. Musical directors are also represented.

This year we would like to welcome Chris Nichols as new director of Acorn Strings and Christopher Braime as new director of the Southampton Youth Orchestra.

The Friends support the orchestras in many ways, for example by raising money to provide new music and new instruments, and by giving financial support for tours and residential weekends. Members of the Friends also provide support at rehearsals, providing refreshments and adult help and at concerts with front of house activities, raffles and hospitality to guests.

The Friends are a support partner of the Southampton Music Hub, which is part of the new funding arrangements that have been in place since 2012. After a period of cuts in funding, Government funding through the Hub has remained the same and will stay the same next year. What will happen to this funding in the longer term is not clear but the Friends will continue to support the orchestras.
