Biographies

Anna Robinson – Director



Anna Robinson trained first as a clarinettist at the University of Southampton where she graduated with a distinction in a Masters in music performance. Anna currently works for Southampton Music Hub as a single reed specialist. Anna thoroughly enjoys conducting Southampton Youth Concert Sinfonia and highlights include conducting the Les Miserables medley on Cotswolds tour 2017, a performance which featured over 80 musicians! Anna regularly features as a clarinettist in newly formed orchestra Magna Sinfonia the most recent concert under the direction of Alaskan Conductor Cayenna Ponchione performing Copland's Appalachian Spring and Sibelius' First Symphony in which Anna was principal. Anna's own musical experiences have encouraged her to work with young musicians to inspire the next generation.

Kevin Withell- Director

Originally a trombonist and pianist, Kevin's first conducting experience came at the age of 16, when he became assistant conductor of the school's Junior Band and musical director of the String Orchestra. Whilst working towards his Masters at University of Southampton, Kevin was assistant conductor of both Southampton University Symphony Orchestra and Southampton University Sinfonietta. Kevin currently conducts a range of ensembles including Southampton University Concert Band, Southampton Youth Concert Sinfonia and is Assistant Conductor of Southampton Youth Orchestra, as well as taking rehearsals with Worthing Philharmonic Orchestra and London Gay Symphony Orchestra and performing regularly as a trombonist and percussionist.



Louisa Broad- Leader



Louisa Broad is a grade 7 violinist in year 8 at The Romsey School. She has been playing the violin since she was 5 and officially became a teenager 3 days ago! This is Louisa's second year in SYCS and she feels it is both an honour and a joy to be leading the orchestra this term. Through her music making, Louisa has taken part in many concerts and master classes. The most recent being with the London Mozart Players, the first chamber orchestra founded in UK in 1949. The experience for Louisa is always an amazing opportunity to meet, play and learn with other musicians. Louisa is also a member of Hampshire Youth String Orchestra, joining in 2016. This gave Louisa the opportunity of performing a solo in Winchester Cathedral last Christmas. Louisa hopes you enjoy this fantastic evening of music with SYCS.

Lily Thorne- Clarinettist

Lily Thorne has been playing the clarinet since she was 7 years old, having been introduced to music through the In2Music scheme. Her first orchestral experience was when she attended Shirley Junior School. Lily later joined the USH Orchestra and played in the pit band for We Will Rock You. Lily has also managed to work her way up through the wind band pyramid, beginning in Clarinet Chorale, progressing to Pulse 8 and then onto Southampton Wind Band. She also plays with Southampton Youth Orchestra and is the principal clarinettist and soloist for Southampton Youth Concert Sinfonia this evening. Lily completed her Grade 8 in December 2015 and was relieved to stop there. Her favourite music to perform is contemporary music, a personal favourite being the Romanza of Poulenc's clarinet Sonata.



Charlotte McKenzie- Vocalist



At the age of eleven, Charlotte joined Bitterne Park School and gained access to many performing opportunities. Since then she has taken part in numerous school and college concerts and productions including Les Miserables, The Sound of Music and Beauty and the Beast, in which she played a lead role. In year four she began taking violin lessons, and joined Southampton Youth Strings at the age of twelve. Charlotte is currently in her first year of college, and enjoys playing violin for both Southampton Youth Concert Sinfonia and Southampton Youth Orchestra. She also enjoys volunteering with Acorn and Elgar Orchestras in the Southampton Pyramid.

FSYO is a charitable organisation whose aim is to support the ensembles that are part of the Southampton Youth Orchestras pyramid (Acorn, Elgar, SYS, SYCS and SYO). The FSYO committee members are parents of current players. Musical directors are also represented.

The Friends support the orchestras in many ways, for example by raising money to provide new music and new instruments, and by giving financial support for tours and residential weekends. Members of the Friends also provide support at rehearsals, providing refreshments and adult help and at concerts with front of house activities, raffles and hospitality to guests.
