Biographies

Anna Robinson – Director SYCS



Anna Robinson trained first as a clarinetist at the University of Southampton where she graduated with a distinction in a Masters in music performance. Anna currently works for Southampton Music Hub as a single reed specialist. Anna thoroughly enjoys conducting Southampton Youth Concert Sinfonia and highlights include conducting Ghostbusters in central hall. Anna regularly features as a clarinetist in a range of orchestras in and around Hampshire, the most recent performance Gershwin's American in Paris as principal clarinetist with Magna Sinfonia under the baton of Cayenna Ponchione. Anna's own musical experiences have encouraged her to work with young musicians to inspire the next generation.

Kevin Withell- Director SYCS

Originally a trombonist and pianist, Kevin's first conducting experience came at the age of 16, when he became assistant conductor of the school's Junior Band and musical director of the String Orchestra. Whilst working towards his Masters at University of Southampton, Kevin was assistant conductor of both Southampton University Symphony Orchestra and Southampton University Sinfonietta. Kevin currently conducts a range of ensembles including Southampton University Concert Band, Southampton Youth Concert Sinfonia and is Assistant Conductor of Southampton Youth Orchestra, as well as taking rehearsals with Worthing Philharmonic Orchestra and London Gay Symphony Orchestra and performing regularly as a trombonist and percussionist.



Charlayne Abby Pueblo “Angel”- Leader



Charlayne started playing the violin at the age of 7. She joined her first orchestra, First Steps at Oakwood, in Year 5. She then started secondary school at St Anne’s and was an active member of the string ensemble and choir, performing in concerts each term. Charlayne continued to be dedicated to a range of ensembles when she moved to

St Georges, taking part in concerts each term and annual productions, as a part of the pit band, including ‘Oliver!’ Soon, Charlayne will be attending Barton Perveril, hoping for more musical opportunities.

Harry Price- Soloist

Harry started playing the violin at the age of 6. He joined his first orchestra, Finzi Strings at Hollybrook, in Year 3. Progressing up through the string pyramid into SYCS in 2016, having joined SYO this term. Over the last 2 years he has taken part in multiple musical productions both within and out of school, including lead-male role in Disney’s ‘The Little Mermaid’ and most recently partaking in a Mayflower production of ‘Annie’. Harry is thoroughly looking forward to performing tonight.

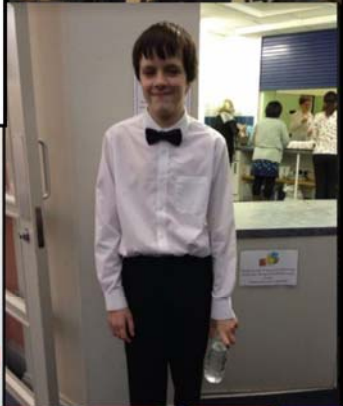
